To complete enrollment:

1. An assessment test will be given by a staff member.
2. The Authorization for Release of School Records form must be submitted to acquire a copy of the most recent achievement test scores, grade report cards of the most recent quarter and one from the previous year, and immunization records.
3. A copy of any divorce / custody decision as it pertains to the student(s) must be submitted.
4. Junior High and High School students must submit a letter explaining why he / she wants to attend The Oaks
5. A Teacher Reference Form(s) for grammar students must be submitted

Resource fees will be charged to each student (\$100 for half-day kindergarten; \$200 for full-day kindergarten; \$150 for grades 1-6; \$175 for grades 7-12) and may be paid in full by July 1, 2021 or combined with the monthly tuition payment. In addition to this fee, students will purchase some of their own books for literature, Latin, etc. The resource fee for grades 7-12 includes an event fee for History Emphasis Days, Civil War Reenactment, Regional Choir Festival, etc.

Registration fees, resource fees, and tuition are non-refundable and non-transferrable.
