Welcome back to the 2019-2020 school year! As we embark upon the new year, we are again reminded of the privilege that it is for us to partner with you parents as you endeavor to raise your children in the nurture and admonition of the Lord.

Those of you who have been a part of The Oaks community for any length of time know that one of the means we have used to communicate with you regarding your student's academic progress has been through the use of attention grabbers for late or failed assignments. At the close of last year, we beta-tested the use of Jupiter for communicating attention grabbers, though we continued to also send along and collect paper copies. The result of our testing period assures us that electronic Jupiter attention grabbers are a more effective and efficient way to communicate with you; consequently, we will be moving to solely electronic attention grabbers this school year in the Logic and Rhetoric School (grades 7-12).

Attention grabber notifications will be clearly identified as such in the email title. Within the body of the email, the pertinent information related to the assignment (when it was due, whether it is late or failed) will be detailed. You will also be directed to your student's Jupiter portal to locate further information.
